On Monday, Feb. 21, children of all ages are invited to have fun learning about animal tracks from around the Black Hills. Julie Brazell, park naturalist at Custer State Park, will teach children how to identify different animal tracks, what the tracks tell us and about different animal habitats. Children will get to see real animal furs, make their own animal tracks and receive a state park giveaway.

This No School Discovery Day will take place at 10:30 at the Downtown Library and 2:30 at the North Branch in General Beadle Elementary School.
